WHAT IS MVGS?

- ✓ MVGS has approximately 210 students on two campuses at Lord Fairfax Community College (LFCC)
- ✓ The Middletown Campus serves Clarke, Frederick, Warren, and Winchester
- ✓ The Warrenton Campus serves Culpeper, Fauquier, and Rappahannock
- ✓ Dual enrollment credit through LFCC is available for most classes
- ✓ Opportunity to earn an Associate's Degree with high school graduation

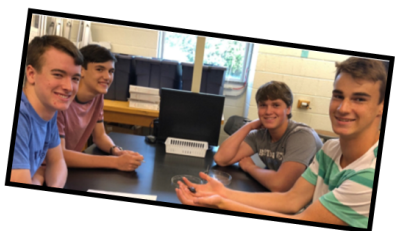
WHAT STEPS CAN **YOU** TAKE?
